State Registration of Agreements on the Lease of Real Estate

On 4 March 2013 the Russian President signed Federal Law No. 21-FZ which reinstates mandatory state registration of agreements on the lease of real estate (the "Law").

The Law, in particular, amends Federal Law No. 302-FZ "On Amendments to Chapters 1, 2, 3 and 4 of Part I of the Russian Civil Code" dated 30 December 2012, *and restores the mandatory requirement for state registration of agreements on the lease of real estate,* including lease of buildings and structures as well as enterprises provided for under Articles 609, 651 and 658 of the Civil Code.

Earlier in December 2012, Federal Law No. 302-FZ amended certain provisions of the Civil Code and, among other things, abolished state registration of certain transactions and preserved state registration of rights and their encumbrances only. Law No. 302-FZ also stipulated that the requirement for state registration of agreements on the lease of real estate would cease on 1 March 2013. The amendments did not fully meet the initially intended purpose of this law and drew a broad resonance (please see our update for 24 December 2012 – 13 January 2013).

The Law entered into force on 4 March 2013.
